After the community meeting in August, the Department of Public Utilities has continued to explore the best alternatives for providing sanitary sewer service to the Hickory Haven & Samary Forest neighborhoods. As part of our ongoing efforts to keep you informed of our progress and of issues which may affect the project, we have scheduled a follow-up community meeting on **Monday, October 28, 2019, at 6:30 p.m. at Company 3 Fire Station** (52 Broad Street Road, Manakin-Sabot, VA).

The meeting will be preceded by an informal public discussion, starting at **5:00 p.m.** This will be an opportunity to speak with us one-on-one about your individual lot.
