Board of Equalization	The board shall sit at the place or places and on the days named therein for the purpose of equalizing real estate assessments in such county or city and for the purpose of hearing complaints of inequalities wherein the property owners allege a lack of uniformity in assessment, or errors in acreage in such real estate assessments (Va. Code § 58.1-3378)	7 (5 regular, 2 alternates)- appointed by county circuit court with recommendations by Board of Supervisors	(1) Members must be resident of the county, broadly representative of the community and a majority must own property in county; (2) 30% shall be commercial or residential real estate appraisers, other real estate professionals, builders, developers, or legal or financial professionals, and at least 1 such member shall sit in all cases involving commercial, industrial or multi-family residential property, unless waived by the applicant; (3) Each member shall attend and participate in the basic course of instruction given by VA. Dept. of Taxation, including continuing education at least once in every four years of service (Va. Code § 58.1-3373; County Code § 13-26)	3 year terms	1 alternate vacancy
Board of Zoning Appeals	To hear and decide appeals of administrative decisions made pursuant to the Zoning Ordinance; hear and decide upon applications for special permits and variances authorized by the Zoning Ordinance; and hear and decide applications for interpretation of the Zoning Map where there is uncertainty as to the location of a zoning district boundary (Va. Code § 15.2-2309)	7- (5 regular, 2 alternates) appointed by county circuit court upon recommendation by Board of Supervisors	Must be residents of the county (Va. Code § 15.2-2308(A))	5 year terms	2 alternate vacancies
Design Review Committee	The Committee shall administer the provisions of section 7.3 of this article, in accordance with duties as set forth herein; and may recommend to the board of supervisors the promulgation of appropriate design standards for the entrance corridor and village center overlay districts established pursuant to this article, as further amendment to this article, as it believes appropriate to supplement the design standards set forth in this article. Such design standards may include but are not limited to architectural standards, building and parking setback standards and landscaping standards. (County Code Appx. A, Art. 22, § 6(a))	3- appointed by local governing body along with 2 alternates	All members shall be residents of the county and shall have a demonstrated interest, competence or knowledge in architectural and/or site design and in the preservation of the natural, scenic and historic resources of the county (County Code Appx. A, Art. 22, § 5(a))	2 year terms not to exceed four consecutive terms	2 alternate vacancies
