# Where We Were

- Infrastructure Needs of the County were Identified 10 Years Ago
- TCSD Debt Loomed Large
  - Great Pressure to Raise Ad Valorem Tax
- Goochland Elementary in Need of Replacement
- Courthouse outdated and does not meet 21<sup>st</sup> Century needs
- New Fire Stations Needed – West Creek Station most imminent
- Broadband Estimates \$15 – \$20 Million

# What We Did

- Conservative Budgeting and Financial Management
- Restructured TCSD Debt in 2012 & 2020 (\$12.8 million net savings)
- Stabilized Ad Valorem Tax
- Established Debt and Fund Balance Policies
- Created Reserves for Future CIP's and Revenue Fluctuations
- Created a 25 Year CIP
- Paid Down Debt – Debt service is 2.6% of GF expenditures

# Where We Are

- Strong fund balance levels
- Debt service historically low and stable
- Favorable revenue and expenditure results
- Long-term planning with a 25 year CIP
- Led to:
  - Standard & Poors – AAA in 2015
  - Moody's – Aaa in 2018
  - Fitch – Pending ???

# Fitch Rating Achieved – Oct 13, 2021

- Triple-Triple
- Top Rating from the Top 3 Credit Ratings Agencies
- Smallest County to Earn Three AAA Bond Ratings
- Able to go directly to the market for the Lowest Interest Rates

# Referendum Questions

On November 2, 2021, two ballot questions will ask Goochland County voters whether the County should be authorized to issue up to \$96 million in General Obligation (GO) bonds to pay for improvements to public facilities. Voters will respond “yes “or “no” to each question.

The proposed bond amounts are:

- Up to \$60 million for school projects
- Up to \$36 million for public safety projects



# Referendum Projects

## School Projects:

- New Elementary School
- HS Expansion
- Bulldog Way and Parking Lot Improvements

## County Projects:

- New Courthouse Complex
- New West Creek Fire Station

No Increase in Real Estate Tax Rate





### What does a Yes Vote Mean?

The County will be able to finance the projects through the bond market. General Obligation Bonds traditionally carry lower overall borrowing costs when compared to other funding options and therefore are considered the most prudent method to finance long-term capital projects.



### What does a No vote mean?

The County would not be able to fund the projects through General Obligation Bonds. The County could finance the projects either through cash funding or through commercial financing. Cash funding would take additional time and commercial financing would include additional administrative costs.

Virginia Code requires county to secure voter approval through a referendum before issuing General Obligation Bonds.

# Broadband Coverage Expansion

- Consultant proposed that County spend \$15M to \$20M to connect unserved areas.
- We have Partnered with Private Providers: Firefly Fiber Broadband, Port 80 Internet Services, Central VA Electric, Rappahannock Electric, Comcast and Dominion Energy
- By end of 2023 high speed broadband will be accessible throughout Goochland
  - Total Investment over \$25 Million
  - County Contribution = \$3.7 Million
  - Firefly & Port 80 connecting 2,993+ locations.
  - Additional funding for “long runs” will be available from a Department of Housing and Community Development “Long Drop” grant program.




# County Broadband Update

## Firefly Fiber Broadband Project

### Project Partners:

- Firefly Fiber Broadband, Dominion, Central Virginia Electric, Rappahannock Electric, Thomas Jefferson Planning District Commission & Goochland County
- 276 miles of fiber connecting 2,765 unserved passings
- USDA ReConnect FY 2019 & 2020, FCC RDOF, VATI 2022 (*applied*)
- \$25,220,000 total project cost
  - \$17,532,500 – Partners
  - \$ 4,050,000 – VATI Request
  - \$ 3,637,500 – Goochland





# County Broadband Update

## VATI Project - Port 80 Internet Service



- Construction began in August 2021
- Extending fiber along Cardwell Rd., Taylor Rd., Covington, Genito Road, a portion of Shallow Well Rd., and Strawberry Run.
- \$915,265.39 total project cost
  - \$567,558 from VATI (DHCD)
  - \$100,000 from Goochland County
  - \$247,707 from Port 80 Internet Services
- 18.92 miles of backbone fiber & 12.96 miles of new drops connecting 228 passings.
- 6.4 miles of fiber and fiber backbone along Cardwell Rd. completed.


## Fairground & Sandy Hook Road Intersection Improvement

## New Route 288 Interchange Study


- Goochland received funds for study
- Steering committee includes VDoT and RVA TPO staff
- Goal is to alleviate traffic and safety concerns at Rte 288 / Broad Street Road intersection and along Route 288

## H.R. 3684: Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act

- Pending funding source for Oilville Road/I-64 interchange
- Alleviate traffic and safety concerns at westbound ramps

## Central Virginia Transportation Authority

- New dedicated funding source for transportation
- First project –Fund Opticom Systems - emergency signal pre-emption system for public safety vehicles
